



Consultation on proposed Admission Arrangements for Great Hollands Primary School for entry from September 2019

Introduction

Great Holland Primary School is an academy school and is its own admission authority, forming part of the Maiden Erlegh Trust. When an admission authority wishes to make changes to their admission arrangements they must consult to ensure all views are heard. Maiden Erlegh Trust is consulting on the following changes to the admission arrangements for Great Hollands Primary School:

- 1. Proposed change to the oversubscribed criteria to include children of staff of Great Hollands Primary School**
- 2. Proposal to remove social/medical criterion from the oversubscription criteria**
