The Girl of Ink and Stars - Kiran Millwood Hargrave

Children will learn to explore themes of courage, friendship, and discovery while developing skills in summarising and questioning complex narrative details.

The Highway man – Alfred Noyes

Children will learn to interpret poetic language, rhythm, and imagery while practising prediction and inference to understand mood and character motivation.

Science

Writing

Understanding the features of different literary genres. Working on a three week cycle the children will have opportunities to imitate a text taught, then innovate as a class and then independently create their own piece of writing.

Literary Genres this half term include:

- Stories with different perspectives – using the Highway man
- Letter writing

- Asking for items in a shop or restaurant
- Asking how much things cost
- Some basic weights
- How to order for others in a restaurant

Design and Technology – Textiles

- Explain how different textile techniques (e.g. stitching, joining, decorating) are used to create or strengthen a product.
- Design and make a functional product using textiles, applying accurate cutting, joining, and finishing techniques.

- Identifying land use in the town
