<u>Carol Vorderman's Maths Factor</u>	This is usually available via a weekly subscription but is currently free to use.
<u>Gareth Metcalfe Maths</u>	Daily lessons for KS1 and KS2 - I See reasoning and problem-solving activities.
<u>Literacy Shed</u>	Short films and stories with prompts for writing.
<u>Audible Stories</u>	Stories free to stream to all devices for the duration of the school closure.
<u>Cosmic Kids Yoga</u>	Yoga, mindfulness and relaxation for kids. Interactive adventures which build strength, balance and confidence.
<u>Edinburgh Zoo Live</u>	Live footage of some of the animals at Edinburgh Zoo. Click to see the penguins, tigers, panda, etc
<u>Twinkl</u>	Parents can use the code 'TWINKLHELPS' to enable free access to a variety of learning materials.
<u>Oxford Owl E-Books</u>	There are over 100, free eBooks suitable for children aged 3-11. Parents and children can choose a book suitable by the child's reading book band, age and interest.
<u>National Literacy Trust</u>	Free reading and writing resources, audiobooks, videos, competitions and reading challenges.
<u>Pobble 365</u>	Use the images as an exciting stimulus to create stories, diary entries and instructional writing.
