- Your child's name and current school, if you have more than one child you can put them all on this form
- Your name, date of birth and national insurance number



- 1. Under current regulations only children whose parents/carers are in receipt of any of the following will be entitled to free school lunches:
- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Job Seeker's Allowance (IBJSA)
- An income related employment and support allowance (this was introduced on 27 October 2008)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit but not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs
- Please note anyone receiving Working Tax Credit, regardless of Income, will not qualify
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.

Children who receive IS or IBJSA in their own right are also entitled to receive free school meals.
