In Reception, the children have been reading the story 'But Martin'. They pretended to be the character from the story, and all joined in singing and acting out alien songs.






### Exploring Science in UKS2 Year 5 and 6 have been

Last Friday, Foxes and Badgers classes had their Superhero day. They thought about and talked about their own superpowers, made some healthy eating snacks and designed a superhero.








#### Year 4 Alien Reports!

Little Musketeers are back offering a fun, safe and educational environment for young children to learn the sport of fencing. What child has not grown up pretending to be a swashbuckling pirate, a duelling Musketeer, or even the master of swordplay himself, Zorro? Why do they do it? Because it's fun!

Little Musketeers provide bright coloured foam and plastic foils and plastic masks with mesh visors that are safe and yet hard enough to give children the real feel of fencing. We ensure visors are worn at all times giving peace of mind as well as that genuine fencing experience.

Little Musketeers classes are designed and managed by Olympic fencer and 4 times British National Champion James Beevers. All staff are CRB checked, First Aid certified and trained personally by James.

This term's course will focus on building your child's self-confidence as well as working on their hand, eye and feet co-ordination! Once the course is completed, they will be awarded with the Green term wristband.
