

Please take a moment to think about keeping safe on our school site. Accidents can be avoided, and we thank you for your support.



### By the Main School Entrance...

Traffic uses the road into school, and we are seeing an increasing number of parents walking in the roadway behind the parked cars when heading down towards our nursery or the Oaks Children's Centre – please use the footpaths, especially when young children are with you.



### By the Bike Sheds...

Our bike sheds are situated in the car park, which is a very busy area at the start and end of the school day. Traffic is moving around both from school and the Oaks Children's Centre and young children **must** be accompanied when going to collect their bike or scooter from there.

**We ask that on arrival and collection you keep your children with you and do not allow them to run off ahead, which helps to keep these busy times safe and calm for all.**
