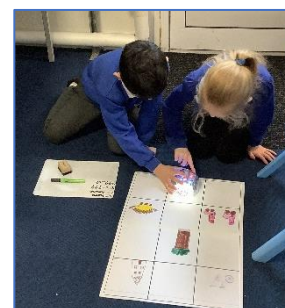
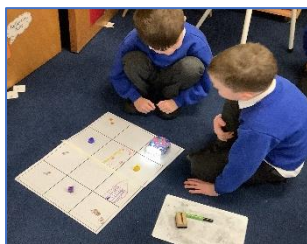
Online booking for our Parents' Evenings (Y1-6) is now open!
