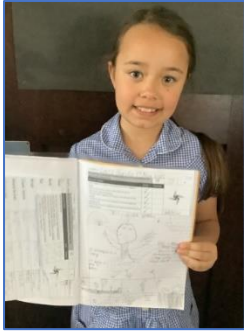
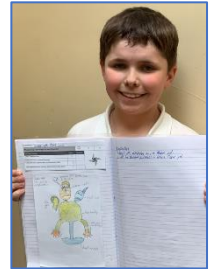


Curriculum Enrichments...



Year 3&4 Ancient Maya

The children in Years 3 and 4 have been continuing their learning about the ancient Maya in their writing this week. They have been creating their own god and will be writing a non-chronological report detailing the god's appearance, personality and attributes!
