

Important Lunches Reminder for Children Moving to Year 3

All children in Year 1&2 receive free school lunches under the Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme.

If your child is moving to Year 3 in September, you will need to begin to pay for lunches provided by the school, unless you are in receipt of Benefit-Related Free School Meals.


