Important News – After School and Morning Club

Over the Easter break, we will at last be going live with our wraparound care booking system, which will be entirely done through ParentPay.

There are a few changes to note:

- Sessions will need to be paid for at the time of booking and are only booked in when payment is received, although there are different arrangements for parents paying with childcare vouchers, who will be emailed separately.
- If sessions are booked, but not attended and they have not been cancelled giving 24 hours' notice, the session charge will still apply.
- All outstanding balances for after school or morning club must be cleared or you will not be able to access the booking system.

To enable us to get the booking system active – changes need to be made on the ParentPay website. This will be done on Wednesday 3rd and Thursday 4th April. We ask that you do not log into ParentPay to make any payments on these dates. We will email to confirm when the system is live and also send out simple instructions for booking.
