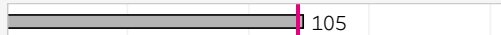

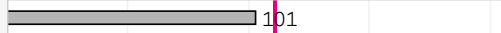

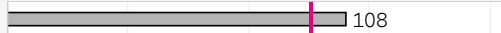
Reading Scaled Score



Writing Scaled Score



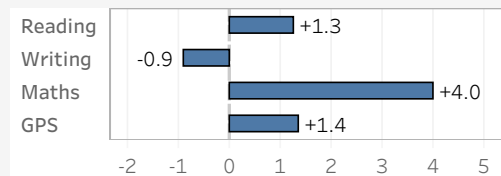
Maths Scaled Score

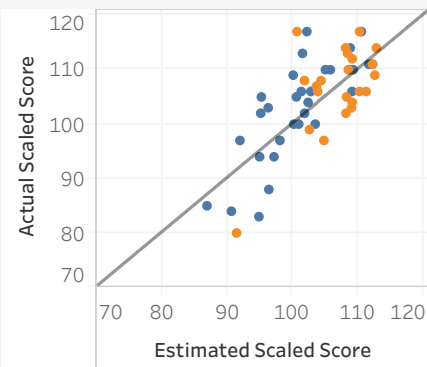

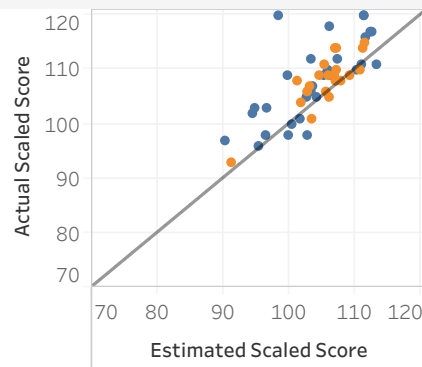
