As part of our unit 'Should we stop eating chocolate?' we will be bringing in a professional chocolatier to work with the children in school. This experience will be part of a special chocolate themed day in Year 4, taking place on **Monday 2nd March 2020**. Children will be coming to school as normal and then taking part in workshops throughout the day.

The day will be split into two educational and hands-on sessions. During the morning there will be an interactive presentation covering the history and science of chocolate, looking at a wide range of chocolate-themed topics. The morning session will finish with a chocolate quiz, based on the presentation.

During the afternoon, the children will be working in small groups, designing and making chocolate pizzas.

We will end the day with prize giving for the quiz and best pizza designs and all the children will get chocolate to take home on the day.

The chocolate used is gluten, gelatine and nut free. The dark chocolate is dairy free.
