Year 5 – Parent Permission for Google Classroom Accounts

In our plans to minimize disruption to your child's learning in the event of a school closure we are investigating the use of Google Classroom.

The use of Google Classroom means that all learning tasks can be seen online and accessible to students. This is a free and secure service providing a safe way for us to connect, share content and access learning.

Due to the age of the students, we are unable to create Google Classroom accounts for the students themselves. We can, however, create accounts for parents of year 5 students. You, as parents, can then log into Google Classroom and under your supervision, your child can access the work set by the staff and any feedback given by them. This will allow us to provide online learning resources for the year 5 students in the event of a potential school closure.

If you wish to opt into this system, we will create an account for you to log into the Google Classroom website. Here, you and your child can find and access any work set by their teacher. In due course, we will contact all parents who have opted in, with their login details, the website address and the class code (which will attach the student to their teacher).
