Contact Tracing App

The NHS contact tracing app launched yesterday (24th September) to help with the fight against covid-19. Further information and links to download the app can be found here: <u>https://covid19.nhs.uk/</u>

It is essential that if you, your child or anyone else in your household have symptoms of COVID-19 you must:

- Not come in to school
- Get tested immediately
- Everyone in your household must stay at home.
