At Great Hollands Primary School, we adopt a zero-tolerance approach to bullying. Every November, we take part in Anti-Bullying Week. This is an opportunity to shine a spotlight on bullying and consider the steps we take together to stop it. Anti-Bullying Week 2020 is taking place from Monday 16 to Friday 20 November and this year the theme is 'United Against Bullying.'

Monday 16 November we are encouraging children and adults to come to school wearing a pair of odd socks. This day sends an important message to everyone that we are unique and are allowed to be ourselves free from bullying. The wackier the socks the better!

We are also running our anti-bullying competition. Children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 are asked to design their very own Anti-Bullying Superhero! When will the winner be revealed?	Friday 27 th November.

Remember to include your name and class on the back. Entries can be on A4 or A3 sized paper. If you need some paper – just ask your teacher.
What should I include?	Try to create a good balance of images and information. The theme for this year's Anti-Bullying Week is 'United Against Bullying.'
Who will judge the entries?	Mrs Watson and Miss Baillie will judge the entries.
When will the winner be revealed?	Friday 27 th November.
