

Please continue to disperse quickly once leaving the site. If your child walks alone to school, please ensure they do not visit local shops and instead travel directly to and from school. Once the children leave the school site, they must ensure they follow the new guidance relating to the lockdown.

Things you can do to help keep the school fully open:

- Arrive at the right time
- Keep your child next to you at all times
- Avoid stopping in walkways
- Keep 2m distance between others

I understand that the current situation is alarming for everyone but I want to reassure you that as a school we are doing all we possibly can to keep our community safe. We have been advised by the immunisation team that the consent form will be closed at 12.00pm on Thursday 3rd December. Please make sure you fill out the form before that date to ensure your child receives their vaccination.

- Everyone in your household must stay at home.

Bracknell Forest Library Service

Great news! Bracknell Library will remain open from Thursday 5th November for the following services:

- Select and collect
- Access to public PCs

Other libraries will also be opening next week for 'select and collect' only. The <u>libraries website</u> will be updated with further details as soon as they become available.

Select and Collect

Select and collect allows you to reserve books from home using the online catalogue or calling the library. You will then be contacted when your items become available when you can come to the library to collect them, safely bagged and already issued to your card. No reservation fees apply for this service.

Public PCs

At Bracknell Library, there will be access to IT services for essential use. To accommodate everyone's needs, this time will be limited to 30 minutes per day and must be booked in advance. You can reserve your slot by calling 01344 423149. Printing and scanning are also available.

There are safety measures in place. We ask that you use sanitising stations and follow the floor guidance both when queuing and inside the building. Please note that the library is not open for browsing, studying or renewing bus passes at this time.
