TikTok Update Parental Controls with Family Pairing Feature

TikTok is used by many teenagers and sometimes children younger than 13 despite its terms and conditions. Using the new Family Pairing feature can allow parents to guide their child's TikTok experience in a safer way. Features include:

- Search Decide what can be searched for. This includes content, users, hashtags or sounds
- Screen Time Management Sets how long your teen can spend on TikTok each day
- Discoverability Decide on the account being private (you decide who can see their content) or public (anyone can search and view content)

Covid-19 Updates

Changes to the number of days contacts are required to isolate

It has been announced today that contacts of confirmed cases will need to isolate for 10 days rather than 14 from Monday. We are awaiting further information about this from the Department for Education and will write to you with further details in due course. Local Information

Bracknell is currently rated as Tier 2 'high' risk and residents will need to follow the rules appropriate for the tier. This means that:

- You must not socialise with anyone you do not live with or who is not in your support bubble
 in any indoor setting, whether at home or in a public place
- You must not socialise in a group of more than six people outside, including in a garden or public space

Department for Education Guidance

We have received the following guidance from the Department for Education that we would like to share with our parents/carers.

- Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for Coronavirus (Covid-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
- For the first six days after teaching ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for Coronavirus (Covid-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.
- School staff are not asked to remain on-call or conduct any contact tracing more than six days after the final day of teaching. Where a schools last teaching day is on Thursday 17 December, there should be no pupil contact tracing asks beyond Wednesday 23 December.

Where pupils are required to self-isolate due to contact with a positive case after the first six days following the end of term, schools do not need to be informed about their absence until the first day of the new term.



Reduce the number of journeys you make and walk or cycle if possible. Avoid busy times and routes on public transport. Avoid car sharing with those outside of your household or support bubble. Avoid entering a Tier 3 area, other than where necessary such as for work or education. Further exemptions apply.

Classes and organised adult sport can take place outdoors, but cannot take place indoors if there is any interaction between people from different households. Organised activities for elite athletes, under-18s and disabled people can continue.

COVID-secure arrangements such as substantial screens, visiting pods, and window visits. Outdoor/airtight visits only (rollout of rapid testing will enable indoor visits including contact)

Sport, live performances and business meetings limited to 50% capacity or 2000 people outdoors (whichever is lower) and 50% capacity or 1000 people indoors (whichever is lower)
