Dear Parents and Carers

Learning covered last week in school and online



Science - The children have started learning about the circulatory system.

Reading - The reading has been focused around our Science work on the circulatory system with the opportunity to answer lots of different question types.

Writing - The children have enjoyed creating their own dreams and writing about these. They started with a setting, developed characters, included dialogue and then worked towards the final story.

Grammar - The children have recapped learning on synonyms, antonyms, suffixes and prefixes.

Spellings - We have been focusing on homophones and looking at spelling rules with suffixes.

PE - The children spent time creating jumping sequences. We were impressed with how creative the children were and enjoyed seeing some of their work via videos.

Year 5 Maths - The children have focused on finding area and perimeter of shapes.

Year 6 Maths - The children have been exploring time. They have converted between 12 and 24 hour clock and have been interpreting timetables.



Behaviour for Learning expectations

We have been very impressed with the positive attitude to learning, the children's resilience and the GREAT behaviour for learning we have seen across the phase. We just wanted to confirm the expectations for all children.

Remote Learning and Behaviour for Learning expectations:

- You should remain muted unless you are asked to unmute to answer a question or the teacher unmutes you.
- Everyone should be listening and tracking the teacher while they are talking.
- If behaviour expectations are not being followed, your teacher will give you a warning. If the behaviour has not improved you will be removed from the lesson and given time to reflect on what changes you are going to make when you are invited back in.
- Use the classroom stream only to share conversations about learning or to ask the teacher a question.
