

# What is happening in Reception this week? 7<sup>th</sup> June 2021

### Literacy



We will be reading another book by Eric Carle this week called 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird'. This is all about a ladybird who doesn't like sharing and is very rude to all the animals they meet. It ends up back where it started and is grateful to share the aphids with the other ladybirds. We will also be continuing with our phonics and having a focus on our writing. Each morning, when we arrive at school, we will be trying to write some words and sentences in our morning work.



This term we are thinking about things that live, move and grow in and on the ground. This week, we continue thinking about underground and are going to look at earthworms. We are going to find out about them and make a class wormery. We are going to explore some messy sensory things and have a go and designing our own garden in a tuff tray.

#### Maths

We are going to be revising our numbers 1-20, practicing



counting, reading and writing our numbers. We will also be practising our adding and subtracting skills. During the week, we will be exploring and developing our doubling skills. We will link it to the ladybird who has the same number of spots on each side.

This term, will be our last term in Reception so we will be working on our transition to Year 1. We will be trying to become even more independent and develop more skills we will need. We will be continuing our focus on listening and speaking and will also now have a focus on independent writing. We will be trying to use our phonics knowledge to write words and simple sentences. We have sent home a copy of the early learning goals and some challenges that you could do to support your child. We have also sent activities you could do linked to our story this week. In school we will be continuing to develop our vocabulary and will be looking at these words from the story 'Owl Babies' we read before half term.
