#### Dear Parents/Carers

As we look towards September and the normality it will hopefully start to bring, we would like to update you on our plans for the next academic year, along with some details for the end of this term.

Our systems across school during this year have been effective, our pupils have adjusted well to the rules and routines and we have been able to operate safely, with only minimal disruption. This has only been possible with support from you all and I would again like to express my gratitude for all that you have done and continue doing in support of our school and the community.

# **School structure for September 2021**

Last year we made some adjustments to our class structure and we will continue this into 2021-22 to enable us to ensure appropriately sized groups of less than 30 pupils each. This is a common model in many primary schools and is just as effective as single year groups for supporting pupils to make good progress in their learning.

Our school structure and associated leaders from September will be as follows:

- 1 EYFS unit comprising of 1 Reception and 1 Nursery class with Ms York as the EYFS leader
- 3 Key Stage One classes with Miss Estcourt as KS1 leader
- 3 Lower Key Stage Two classes with Mrs Watson as Lower KS2 leader
- 2 Year 5 and 2 Year 6 classes with Mrs Ajewole as Upper KS2 leader.

Your child will be in a class with children from their phase of the school.

Phase 1 - Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Nursery and Reception

Phase 2 - Key Stage One (KS1) Years 1 and 2

Phase 3 - Lower Key Stage Two (LKS2) Years 3 and 4

Phase 4 - Upper Key Stage Two (UKS2) Years 5 and 6

# **Year 3 Parents:**

Please note, if your child is going into Year 3, they are no longer entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals or free fruit at break time. You are welcome to send your child in with a healthy snack for break time if you wish.

Unless you are in receipt of Benefits Related Free School Meals, school dinners will need to be paid for. You will need to have credit on your online account and pre-order dinners for your child or you are welcome to provide a packed lunch.
