Mathletics

To help you support your children's reading from home, please visit the phonics links, which we will be sending to your email, containing RWI online sessions. Please keep reading with them and reading to them to help further develop their reading, language and listening skills.

It's a great way to encourage reading over the summer and children can take part online or by visiting their local library and earn rewards for taking part. Learning activities have also been uploaded onto Google Classroom. Children will remain in their current online class until we return in September, when they will join their new classes as they continue to use Google Classroom to support their learning journey.
