Dear Parents and Carers

Year 2 SATs

At the end of Key Stage 1, we will judge the standard that your child is working at in English, Maths and Science.

In May, Year 2 pupils will complete national curriculum tests in Maths and English, known as standard attainment tests (SATs). We use these assessments along with your child's work throughout the year, to assess your child's performance and, as they move up to Key Stage 2, identify their needs.

In Year 2 the children are used to having assessments each term, we call them quizzes and we incorporate them into everyday teaching, your child may not even realise that they have taken them!

Pupils will sit six short assessments: Reading Paper 1, Reading Paper 2, Maths Reasoning, Maths Arithmetic and Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar. The assessments will be completed in small groups with a familiar adult.

You will receive Key Stage 1 assessment results in end of year reports in July.

Please continue to support your child at home by completing all homework, reading regularly with your child, and asking them questions about the book they are reading.

If you have any questions about Key Stage 1 assessments, please do not hesitate to ask your child's class teacher.
