Dear Parents and Carers

With the end of the school year fast approaching, it is time to turn our attentions towards this year's residential trip to Runways End with Year 6.

We are sure that both you and the children are excited and nervous for the trip and so we are providing a parent information evening at school **from 5.00pm on Tuesday 14th June**, to give you as parents and children some information on what we will be doing and how the trip will run, as well as opportunities to answer any questions.

In preparation for the trip, the centre has provided us with the list below of recommended essential items, which the children will require. If you need any support in equipping your children with any of the items listed, please let either your child's teacher or the school office knows as soon as possible.

Recommended essential Items

Sleeping Bag

Bottom Sheet

Pillow in a pillowcase

Towel

Wash kit (shower gel, deodorant, toothbrush, etc)

Water bottle

Torch

Plastic bag / bin liner for laundry and wet clothes

Whole body covering pyjamas

Warm jumper or fleece and a hat and gloves - even in summer it can be cool in the evenings Waterproof jacket and trousers

Change of clothes for each day

One set of smart clothes (for a disco)

Two pairs of comfortable trainers – we are going on the water so one pair may get wet (water shoes are also fine if you have them but not essential)

Slippers, sliders, or clean indoor shoes

Sun cream and sun hat

Medication (where appropriate given to your Group Leader)

No child is permitted to bring their mobile phone or any other electronic devices. They will be excited to tell you all about their time away when they return. School staff will be contactable via the school office should any urgent needs arise.

Children may bring a snack for the morning, but they will not require a lunch for the first day, as we will eat on arrival at the centre.
