


Weekly Update

Summer Safety

What a scorcher it has been today! I do hope you managed to keep cool in whatever you have been doing.

Please remember water bottles and to apply sunscreen to your child before coming to school when the UV levels are so high.

We are fortunate to have some lovely, shaded areas on our field and playgrounds and we adapt learning, including PE and playtimes, to take account of the weather but the children will have some time in the sun so sunscreen is advised. Please remember we ask you to provide sun hats for the children not sunglasses.

During the summer months, please do remember the following:

- Always make sure your child has a named sensible sun hat in school.
- Drinking water is vital please make sure your child has a named water bottle in school every day.
- Apply a long-lasting sunscreen to your child in the morning before they come to school.
