Dear Parents and Carers

In connection with our Topic this term, 'How did families have fun in the past?', we would like to take the children out for a trip to **Littlehampton on Tuesday 5 July**.

It will be an exciting day out where they will undertake fieldwork on a seaside town, exploring the seaside environment and making observational sketches. We also plan to have a picnic lunch on the beach, weather permitting, and will visit the RNLi and take part in a workshop to talk and learn all about the important role that they play.

We are always very conscious of trying to keep costs to parents to a minimum but unfortunately, due to rising prices, this trip should cost £20 per pupil. We understand that the cost of living is making things difficult for many families, so the school will subsidise the trip by £5 for each pupil, which will make the voluntary contribution cost to parents on this occasion £15 per pupil.

Please make payment for this trip using ParentPay, where you will also be able to electronically give consent for your child to come on the trip. **Please do this by Thursday 30 June**. If we do not receive sufficient contributions towards the trip unfortunately it will have to be cancelled as there are no school funds to contribute beyond what is already subsidised.

Due to the length of the coach journey, we will be leaving at 9.00am and returning to school at 4.30pm. If our return is delayed for any reason, the office will notify you by text and email.
