Sports Day 2022

I am delighted to inform you that after considerable efforts we are able to have a Sports Day for our pupils this year and we are able to welcome parents to watch, should they wish. As this is our first one since Covid, we are excited to be able to return to this annual event.

The event will take place on **Friday 15 July**

The **Key Stage 2 Sports Day** will take place between **9.30am – 11.30am**.

Key Stage 1 Sports Day will take place between **1.45pm -2.45pm**.

Children will have their lunch in school as normal and parents will leave the school site in between each event. Gates will be open from **9.15am** for the morning event and **1.30pm** in the afternoon. Please enter and exit the playgrounds as normal.

The children will stay in the same group and will move round from one event to the next. They will score points for their Houses depending upon whether they come 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th. The House with the most points at the end of the day will be declared Sports Day Champions 2022.

We hope that the weather will stay on our side on the day, but should we need to cancel the event due to the unpredictable nature of our summertime, we will inform all parents via text message.

All children are expected to wear their normal PE kit (children will get changed in school) but are encouraged to wear a t-shirt in their House colours.

There will be several activities for the children to participate in during the day and they will take part in each of these in a round robin. Once all teams have completed the circuit, there will be a number of relay style events that all the children will participate in. Bring your loudest cheering voice!

Some reminders of our expectations for events:


- This is a viewing only event and parents are asked to keep to the marked parent areas and allow the school staff to manage the event and support the children.
