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Dear Parents and Carers

Sports Day this year for Years 1-6 will be held tomorrow (Friday) on the school field. The event this year will be modified slightly due to the heat and we won't be holding any relay events or class races.

This year, children will move around the different activities in their class group, with their teachers. All the activities are in line with the skills they have been developing in the PE lessons.

We have included a plan for the event, so that you can see where your child's class will be starting and they will move from left to right through the activities.

Children can come to school wearing their PE kit, including a t-shirt in their house colour.

*Amber – Yellow*

*Emerald - Green*

*Sapphire – Blue*

*Ruby - Red*

Children in Key Stage 2 may also wish to bring in a normal school polo shirt to change into after the event as they will be hot and sticky.

Please also send them in with a named sun hat and apply long lasting sun cream in the morning before they come to school.

Parents and carers are welcome to come and watch, although we do ask that you keep to the parent areas and don't call your child over to you or let any younger children wander past the boundaries. We also ask that you don't take pictures or videos, to respect the privacy rights of other families and children.

If any younger children need to use the toilet, they will be able to use the ones by the school gym, however adults who need to use the toilet must go around to main school reception.

Parents and carers will enter and exit via the gate by Cunworth Court, we do ask that you are mindful of our neighbours when entering and exiting the school site.

After each event, children will return to their classrooms and continue their normal school day, there will be no early collection for either Key Stage.

### **Key Stage 2 (Year 3-6)**

The activities for Key Stage 2 will take place from 9.30am until approximately 11.30am, although they may finish earlier than planned.

Pupils will work in pairs or individual on each activity and staff will keep track of overall scores to see how each house has ranked on each event, before moving on to the next station. We have added an extra rest stop for the children and they will have access to water at each event.

When all the events are finished, children will be awarded with a trophy sticker and applauded for their great efforts. This will mark the end of the event and parents and carers are asked to make their way out of the school site as quickly as possible.

**Key Stage 1 (Year 1-2)**

The activities for Key Stage 1 will take place from 1.45pm until approximately 2.45pm, although they may finish earlier than planned.

Pupils will work in small teams in their class groups, so that events are kept short and we will ensure that children have access to water at each activity.

When all the activities are finished, children will be applauded for their great efforts. This will mark the end of the event and parents and carers are asked to make their way out of the school site as quickly as possible.

**After the event**

The final combined total scores for KS1 & 2 will be added up and the winning house will be announced during an assembly. The members of the winning house will earn a non-uniform day of the last day of term.
