Year 6 Residential Trip 2023

Dear Parents and Carers

As you will be aware, we have been looking into the possibility of arranging a residential trip for our Year 6 children. Our parent survey last term has enabled us to explore a range of options based on parent/carer responses as a result of this feedback we have chosen the following option:

A 3-day, 2-night residential trip: Monday 10 - Wednesday 12 July 2023

The cost for the trip will be approximately £200 per pupil, which is subject to change depending on the number of pupils attending the trip. The cost includes:

- Coach travel
- Full catering
- Adventure activities
- Day-time activities led by qualified instructors
- Exclusive use of the accommodation unit.

To confirm your child's place, we require a deposit of £50 paid via ParentPay by Friday 2nd December.

To help support those who may struggle to pay the £50, the school will support those who need it by allowing the payment to be split into two payments:

- £25 by 2 December 2022
- £25 by 31 January 2023

In all cases a payment by 2nd December will guarantee your child's place on the trip. Requests to attend after this date cannot be guaranteed.

In the new year, once we have established the number of attendees on the trip, we will confirm the final cost and send out the payment schedule.
