In connection with our topic work on transport this term, we have planned to take our KS1 classes to Brooklands Motor Museum, Weybridge, Surrey.

This trip is planned for Tuesday 31 January and will form part of the children's History, Science, English and DT studies for this term.

The children will have the opportunity to take part in a 'Journeys on Land' workshop where they will explore the collection of old bicycles, a Penny Farthing, and Formula One racing cars to find out just how varied the materials we use to build land transport can be. We will also be visiting the Bus Museum and Aircraft Factory.
