Teacher Strike Action – Wednesday 1st February

School Closed to Most Pupils

As you know, on the day of the strike we will be running on **very low staffing levels** and the following arrangements will happen:

- **Nursery and Reception Classes will be open as usual.**
- **All other classes will be closed.**

Parents of children who have been offered a place in our emergency provision have had an personal invitation by email. **If you have not received an invitation email, we will not be able to accommodate your child so they should not attend school on Wednesday 1st February.**

We have undertaken a risk assessment and are unable to safely provide provision for any more children than have already been allocated a space.

If your child is vulnerable or you are a C1 worker and you completed the form and have not received an invitation email for your child but believe you should have, please contact the school office urgently.

For children who are not attending school

Pupils who are unable to attend school due to closures will have a remote learning package of mathematics, reading and writing and this resource will be available on your child's Google Classroom page on the day.

If your child is in Nursery or Reception class and has been offered a place in school on Wednesday 1st February, there will be a change of drop off and collection arrangements for the day:


- Nursery and Reception children – Normal arrangements.
