Dear Parents and Carers

In connection with our topic work on forces in the Summer term, we have planned to take our Year 3 and 4 classes to Winchester Science Centre.

This trip is planned for Thursday 29th June 2023 and will be part of the children's Science, English and DT studies.

The children will have the opportunity to take part in a 'Exploring Rocketship' workshop with a focus on gravity and the forces we use in everyday life. They will be able to explore the science centre and get hands on with the exhibits as well as experience a planetarium show.

To make it possible for this trip to take place we would ask you to make a contribution of £20. It is important to remember that without these contributions there is a likelihood of the trip being cancelled as the school no longer receives funding towards trips. Please make payment for this trip using ParentPay (www.parentpay.com) by **1st June 2023**, where you will also be able to electronically give consent for your child to come on the trip.

Children will need to bring a named packed lunch with them on the day, which we would prefer to be fully disposable so it can be thrown away after they have finished eating, as well as a disposable water bottle.
