Some parents mentioned that they were worried about contacting teachers as they were busy people.	Going forwards we will:  - Strengthen the opportunity for parents to speak with a senior member of staff who will be on duty on the playgrounds before and after school. (You may need to venture into the Year 1&2 playground – as we will not always be on the Year 5&6 playground!)
Compared to most schools you found attending school events more difficult.	We understand the difficulties for hard working parents to find time to come to all school events, but we still want to offer the opportunity for those parents that can attend.  The feedback on parents' evening is that the remote offer is generally seen to be the preferred option, and to balance this we plan to offer more opportunity for parents to see the school in action on open mornings or lesson drop ins.  Going forwards we will:  - Aim to hold events close to drop off or pick up times Support parents in helping the children understand that not all parents are able to make every event.
