KS1 Trip to the Living Rainforest

Dear Parent/Carer

In connection with our topic on the Amazon Rainforest next term, we are planning to take our KS1 classes to The Living Rainforest where they will get to explore the rainforest without leaving the UK!

Our visit will include a guided tour called "Amazing Adaptations" which focuses on how plants and animals have adapted to living in a rainforest environment. The children will learn about the different layers of the rainforest and the wide variety of foods that come from there. This day trip is planned for **Tuesday 4th July 2023** as part of the children's science and geography studies.

We are mindful of trying to keep costs to parents to a minimum and will be undertaking some fundraising activities to raise some of the money needed to cover the cost of the trip. This means that the contribution amount required will be £20 per pupil.
