Teacher Strike Action - Update for Wednesday 5th & Friday 7th July

As a school we are seeing more staff deciding to take industrial action due to the crisis in educational funding. I see the anguish our teachers go through when deciding what action to take and I know they do not make these decisions lightly, I also see the turmoil many schools are in when trying to do their best with limited resources.

Because our staff have shared their intentions in advance, we are able to plan and give plenty of notice to our families. I would like to thank our GHPS staff for doing this as we have seen that many schools have been unable to inform parents until the morning of the strike

For each day of strike action, I have to carefully consider staffing levels and plan accordingly. Following government guidance and our own risk assessments the following arrangements will be put into place.
