## **About our Club**

GHPS Morning Club is managed and run by Great Hollands Primary School. The club is open from **8.00am** weekdays, during term time.

We are based in the Silver Hall, which enables us to take advantage of the facilities within the secure school grounds.

## <u>Aims</u>

We aim to provide a safe, secure and relaxed environment, providing a range of activities to reflect the interests of the children in our care and enabling a smooth transition to the start of their school day.

# What we offer

Children are able to choose between a variety of activities to enjoy as they wish at the club. There will always be a selection available including Lego, colouring, quiet reading and board games.

We do not provide breakfast and ask parents to ensure that children have had their breakfast before arriving at club.

We always ensure drinking water is available.

## Staff

Our club is staffed by members of our school team.

Admin support is provided by Mrs Wise.

All our staff are also employed in various other roles and areas of the school and are all DBS checked.

# **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### Admission

Our club is only accessible for children attending Great Hollands Primary School, from Reception to Year 6. We require a completed registration form for your child before they begin to attend the club. This information will be treated as confidential and will be stored appropriately.

# Payment of fees

The current fees are as follows:

One child - £3.00 Additional siblings - £2.00 each

Fees are payable at the time of booking and must be paid either weekly or monthly in advance.

Payments should be made via ParentPay.

Parents/carers who pay via Childcare vouchers should email Mrs Wise to confirm when payment has been made, this will then be confirmed and added to the child's ParentPay account.

All places at club will be confirmed via email once payment has been received.

## Changes to days and cancelling your child's place

You must give us notice if you do not wish your child to attend club on any booked day. We require 48 hours' notice or fees may still apply.

If you wish to book your child into club, you must give at least 48 hours' notice to enable us to ensure appropriate staffing levels. Failure to do so may result in your child being unable to attend club on that day.

#### Arrivals and departures

When children arrive at club, they are signed in by a member of staff. Children must be brought to Morning Club by an adult or responsible older sibling. They should not arrive unaccompanied.

At the end of the session, children are escorted to their classrooms by a member of staff, ready to begin their learning for the day.





### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

## Behaviour (Children)

The Club promotes an atmosphere of care, consideration and respect for everyone attending, including children, staff and visitors.

We encourage appropriate behaviour through praise for good behaviour; emphasis on co-operative play and sharing; talking to children with the courtesy that we expect from them and engaging children in activities.

# Behaviour (Adults)

We will not tolerate from any person, whether a parent, carer or visitor: bullying; aggressive, confrontational or threatening behaviour; or behaviour intended to result in conflict. Our Club is a place of safety and security for the children who attend and the staff who work here.

When dropping off your child, please use the doorbell on the Silver Hall doors to alert staff of your presence. Your child will then be signed in by staff and taken through to Silver Hall.

#### Illness

If your child becomes unwell whilst at the Club, we will contact you and ask that you arrange for them to be collected.

### **Accidents and First Aid**

Every precaution is taken to ensure the safety of the children at our Club. There is always a qualified first aider present and we have a fully stocked first aid kit. If your child has an accident whilst in our care, we will notify you by telephone. Details of the injury will be noted in the Club's Accident Record Book.
