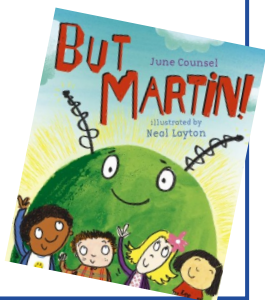
Literacy

Learning Together

The children have been learning school routines and are becoming more independent. They have been learning how to line up quietly and walk through the school to the dinner hall. They have been carrying their own lunch trays from the serving hatch to their space in the dining hall and have been doing all of this so well!

They have been making new friends and having fun exploring their new learning environment. They have been learning how to use different areas and learning how to tidy up and put things away.
