## **KS1 Trip to Hampton Court Palace**

## Dear Parent/Carer

In connection with our topic, "Why was a castle built here?" next term, we are planning to take our KS1 classes to Hampton Court Palace where they will get to develop skills of historical enquiry using Hampton Court Palace as source material.

Our visit will include an interactive school session "Entertaining the Tudors" where we will find out who did the entertaining at the Tudor court and the importance of their roles. The children will also have the chance to play some Tudor games themselves! This day trip is planned for **Thursday 11**<sup>th</sup> **January 2024** as part of the children's History and Geography studies.

We are very fortunate that we were awarded The Historic Royal Palaces (HRP) Access Fund for Schools. The Fund covers the cost of general admission as well as a facilitated session for all children and travel subsidies to assist with transport costs. This means that the contribution amount required will be £7.45 per pupil.

Please make payment for this trip using ParentPay by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> January, where you will also be able to electronically give consent for your child to come on the trip.

Children will need to bring a named packed lunch with them, which we would prefer to be fully disposable, but can be within a backpack if you wish, as long as your child can easily manage to carry it for the day.
