BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING

At Great Hollands Primary School, we have a consistent whole school approach to behaviour for learning. We expect all children to display good behaviour for learning and be ready to learn in order to maximise their progress. Each class has a behaviour for learning display.

All children start the day on green on the behaviour chart and get to move up if they show particularly good behaviour for learning. If a child is not showing good behaviour for learning they are moved to the reflection zone where they reflect on what they need to do to move back to green.

Children on gold at the end of the day receive a "**GREAT B4L**" certificate to take home.

HOME LEARNING

Reading:

To help develop your child's independent reading skills we expect all children to read books at home in order to become proficient readers and develop a love of reading. In Year 3 and 4 we encourage the children to read everyday at home. Children can bring books home from school to read, our libraries are fully stocked!

Please can you ensure you or your child sign their diary every time they have read at home as the children will receive a weekly reward for their commitment to reading at home.

Times Tables Rockstars!

Your child will be given their own TTRS app login. The app allows the children to practice their tables at their own pace or against the clock with the aim of reducing the time taken to recite their tables. The app promotes engagement through games and it awards trophies at each level, and it then highlights the child's results to their teacher.

Spellings will be sent home via email on a Friday to be tested the following Friday.

The children will be required to write sentences using 5 of their spelling words. The words from the list they choose is up to them, but they must be reminded to use the correct punctuation.

We will give children lots of strategies in class to help them learn their spellings i.e. saying them; writing them out in different colours; making up rhymes; or a combination of all of these.

Mathletics Home Learning will be will be set on Mathletics on a Monday to be completed by the following Monday. However, Mrs Watson's maths group will have a practical maths task. Every child has access to Mathletics with their own username and password, which can be found at the front of their diaries.

It is a fun way to practise all areas of Maths and has brilliant mini-teaching videos if they get stuck and allows pre-
