During June, your child will undertake the Phonics Screening Check (PSC). This is a short nation-wide check that all Year 1 children across the country take, to see if they have developed the expected level of phonics knowledge at the end of Year 1.

We will be holding a short information meeting for all Year 1 parents on Thursday 25th April at 2.45pm and entry will be via the Silver Hall doors.

The meeting should give you an understanding of what the Phonics Screening Check is about and you will have the opportunity to ask any questions you have in relation to phonics.

You could play lots of games with them where they must blend sounds together – just like Fred Talk. These could be longer words like target, picnic, sleeping or they can be nonsense (alien) words such as joald or felb. Please tell them if it is a real or alien word before they try to blend it. They will be told this in the screening check in school.

The children should still read their books as usual, and this additional sound practice will help them to make even better progress.
