Dear Parents and Carers

Over the half term break we will again be having a swimming pool set up at our school for three weeks. The pool will give the opportunity for all children in Years 3-5 to have swimming lessons from qualified swimming teachers.

Swimming is vital life skill and by having a pool set up at school, it will enable us to give our pupils a great opportunity to learn to swim while keeping lost learning time in other subjects minimised as we do not need to spend time and money transporting the children to and from a pool.

The cost of swimming lessons can be very expensive, and an intensive week-long course such as we are offering can cost around £80 or more. We feel this is a fabulous opportunity to help your child learn to swim at a significant reduction in cost.

Each year group will have five 45-minute lessons over the course of a week, as detailed in the table below.

**Information: the details:**

- The company we are using is called Elite Swimming.
- The pool is heated and will be set up inside a marquee.
- The company provide a swimming teacher and a lifeguard.

We are planning for the children will swim during the following dates. They will be sorted into small groups, based on their swimming ability.

Monday 3 <sup>rd</sup> to Friday 7 <sup>th</sup> June	<b>Year 5: Panthers – Lions</b>
Monday 10 <sup>th</sup> to Friday 17 <sup>th</sup> June	<b>Year 3: Hawks – Falcons</b>
Monday 17 <sup>th</sup> to Friday 21 <sup>st</sup> June	<b>Year 4: Hawks - Eagles</b>

It is very important that you complete one for each child you have in school in Years 3-5. This will enable us to set up the initial groups and the swimming teacher will move them around as needed.

### Action: get prepared:

On your child's swim days, they need to bring a named bag containing the following:

- Swimsuit (no bikinis) or swim shorts
- Swim hat (every child must wear one)
- Towel
- Dressing gown or a warm covering
- Shoes to walk to and from the pool e.g., crocs/ slip on shoes

Your challenge is to get the kit dried and ready for the next day!


### Information: the cost

As with all wonderful opportunities there is a cost involved. The cost to the school is over £50 per pupil, but we are able to subsidise this cost and ask for a voluntary **contribution of only £25, which equates to £5 per lesson.**
