Diwali Workshop

On Friday 25th October 2024 the children in Nursery, Reception and Years 1-4 will be taking part in a music workshop around the celebration of Diwali led by Wisemoves Dance.

The children will begin their session with an introduction to the Hindu faith and learn why Diwali is an important event in the Hindu calendar. They will then listen to the story of Rama and Sita and discover why dance and music are a big part of the celebrations.

By the end of the session, they should be able to dance a short cultural dance. All of the workshops are hands-on, multi-sensory experiences, suitable for all year groups involving dance, movement and music.

As we do not receive any additional funding for these important enrichment activities, we are asking for a voluntary contribution to help cover the cost of these workshops.

There is a slightly different cost for the children in Nursery and Reception, as the workshops are tailored differently for the younger aged children.

For children in Nursery and Reception, we are asking for a contribution of £1.50 per child.

For children in Years 1-4, we are asking for a contribution of £3.20 per child.
