Dear Parents/Carers

### What are they watching / sharing online?



As part of our commitment to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all pupils, we are contacting you to highlight an important issue that has recently come to our attention regarding mobile phone usage among our Year 6 pupils.

We have noticed a concerning increase in pupils **sharing inappropriate content** with each other via their mobile phones. Some pupils have been creating groups that share adult content, while others are using their phones late at night or early in the morning in their bedrooms. These behaviours can have serious implications for their safety as well as their well-being and mental health.

Please take the time to monitor your child's usage and consider keeping mobile phones out of bedrooms at night.

To help ensure your child's online safety, you should consider the following:

- **Monitor your child's mobile phone activity** regularly to ensure they are engaging in safe and appropriate conversations and are not accessing and/or sharing adult content.
- **Set clear boundaries** regarding mobile phone use, such as keeping phones out of bedrooms at night and establishing screen time limits.

- **Discuss online safety** with your child, reinforcing the importance of responsible digital behaviour and the risks associated with inappropriate content.
- **Encourage open conversations** so that your child feels comfortable discussing any concerns they may have about their online experiences.
