Year 3&4 Trip to Kew Gardens

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our learning this year we will be taking a school trip to **Kew Gardens** on **Wednesday 21st May 2025**.

Why are we going on this trip?

The visit to Kew Gardens will support our learning in **Science** and **Geography**, where we are studying plants, ecosystems, and the environment. It will be a wonderful chance for students to experience firsthand the diverse plant species and ecosystems that we've been learning about in the classroom. They will also have the opportunity to explore the stunning landscapes and learn about conservation efforts at one of the world's most famous botanical gardens.

Details of the trip

We will leave school as close to 9.00am as possible and will be returning by the end of the school day, traffic permitting.

In order to make this trip possible we ask you to make a voluntary contribution of **£15** per child by **Friday 9th May 2025**. This should be paid via ParentPay where you will also be asked to give consent for your child to come on the trip.

Ideally your child will have a **small lightweight backpack** in which they can carry their lunch, water bottle and a raincoat i.e. a pac-a-mac.

Children should wear full school uniform but may wear trainers or school shoes, as their will be lots of walking. Children in receipt of free school meals will be able to order a packed lunch provided by the school kitchen.
