



## **Outcomes of our Annual Surveys 2025**

Thank you all for your positive comments and kind words in our recent survey. It is wonderful to know that the hard work undertaken by school staff is valued by our community.

Your feedback is vital to us. It has a real impact on the work we do at school.

All your feedback is fully reviewed by myself and my senior leadership team. We look at it in detail when we are planning our school developments for the following year. Your views are a large feature of our school improvement system where feedback trends appear we add actions to address this into our school planning documents.

The results are benchmarked against National Primary Data – September 2024

The areas you consider us to be doing well in are...

- *Mutual Trust and Respect*
- *Parental Confidence*
- *Communication Methods*
- *School Accessibility*
- *Pupil Needs*
- *Parents' Evenings*
- *Informing Parents*

The results showed that particular strengths include:

- *How likely you are to recommend the school to other parents?*
- *How does the school's approach to attendance fit your child's needs?*
- *How easy or difficult is it to contact the school if you need to?*

The results of the survey also showed you find are largely satisfied with the school's efforts to engage you as parents, but that you feel you could be more informed regarding your child's homework.

We also found the results demonstrated that the school is easily accessible for parents to get in touch but that there is a lack of clarity on the role of Maiden Erlegh Trust in the school.



## **Results from Pupil Surveys**

Our pupil surveys are incredibly important to us and enable us to really gain an understanding of how our pupils feel about their school.

Results tell us that pupils think we are doing well with the following:

- *Pupils feel safe and secure at school*
- *Pupils love the structure and routine provided by our clear rules and expectations*
- *Pupils say that they read books outside of lessons*
- *Pupils say that their teachers help them do better at school*

## **Focus for this year...**

The results of the pupil survey gave us some areas that pupils would like us to work on:

- *Continue to focus on finding ways to help pupils read more books when not at school*
